Subject	Content	How you can support at home
Communication and Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can ask and respond to 'why' questions. I can remember and join in with rhymes and stories I like. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share favourite stories, books and rhymes together. Talk about the pictures and ask questions about the story.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I enjoy the responsibility of carrying out small tasks. I can demonstrate friendly behaviour, initiating conversations and form good relationships with friends and familiar adults. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage children to join in with tidy-up routines at home.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can use a pincer grasp. I can show increasing control over an object in pushing, patting, throwing, catching or kicking it. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Play with pegs, tweezers, buttons or stickers Play running and catching games, such as 'piggy in the middle' Practice catching with balloons, ribbons or scarves.
Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can read individual letters by saying the sounds for them. I can blend taught sounds to read and spell cvc words. I can read tricky words; the, is, I, as, and, has, his, her, go, no, to, into, she, he, of, we, me, be 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage children to hear and say the initial sounds of words. Say individual sounds for children to practice blending together, eg – p,i,g . Share reading practice books together
Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can talk about my favourite books. I can give meaning to my marks as I write. I can identify sounds from my own name in other words. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Share stories together Encourage children to practice writing their name, using their name card as a guide. Draw pictures of their favourite characters.
Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can recognise, count and compose numbers 1,2,3,4,5. I am beginning to subitise (recognising an amount without counting) I can identify circles, triangles and shapes with 4 sides and talk about their properties 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Count everyday objects around the home; shoes, spoons, toys. Go on a 'shape walk' around your home – which shapes can you find? Look at quantity when playing with counters; who has more or less? Do we have an equal amount?
Understanding the World	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can recognise and describe special times or events for family or friends I understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around me. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about family celebrations; birthdays, Christmas, Diwali, bonfire night. Go on an autumn walk around your local area – what signs of autumn can you see?
Expressive Arts and Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> I can sing to myself and make up simple songs. I can draw with increasing complexity and detail 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Enjoy singing rhymes and favourite songs together. Can you dance to the music? Draw pictures of favourite people, places and story characters.
