Communication and Language	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Listen carefully to others and respond appropriately. Be confident to speak in a group or class. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage your child to show eye contact, careful listening and appropriate responses in conversation.
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Know our school values and expectations and understand why they are important. Make good learning and behaviour choices independently. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Talk about our learning powers and our vision, “Be Kind, Be Brave, Be Happy” and why this is important.
Physical Development	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learning skills needed for sports day races. Developing climbing and jumping skills using apparatus. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Play jumping games like hopscotch. Discuss how races work.
Phonics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Blending and segmenting longer words with the following phonemes: sh, ch, th, ng, qu, ck, oi, oa, ow, oo, ar, or, ur, ear, air, ure Learning to read the tricky words said, so, have, like, some, come, were, there, little, one, do, when, out, what 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ensure your child is confident with previous tricky words: I, to, the, no, go, is, he, she, me, we, be, was, my, you, they, her, all, are
Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Writing simple sentences and reading them back independently. Writing words containing digraphs especially sh ch th ng ai ee igh oa oo. Continuing to practise correct letter formation. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage your child to use correct letter formation when writing.
Mathematics	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Addition and subtraction within 20. Number bonds to 5 and 10. Number formation. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practising showing numbers to 10 using fingers. Find number bonds to 5 and 10 using fingers. Practise writing different numbers.
Understanding the World	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Exploring Space, Dinosaurs and Oceans. Comparing habitats. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visit the library and share fiction and non-fiction books together based on Space, Dinosaurs or Oceans.
Expressive Arts and Design	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Perform stories, songs, rhymes and poems confidently. Adapt and develop their creative processes to improve their work. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Encourage them to share familiar stories and songs. Praise them for improving their work.
