



Woodthorpe Infant School is a County Infant School for children from 4-7 years of age. It serves a catchment area in the County of Nottinghamshire about six miles from the City Centre and it can accommodate approximately 180 children. It is an oversubscribed school with about two thirds of the pupils coming from within the catchment area. Most of the pupils transfer to Arno Vale Juniors, with whom there are good links.

The strengths of the school include embracing the needs of the whole child, encouraging high academic standards whilst also developing important social skills, good behaviour and supportive colleagues, parents and governors. Our last OFSTED, in January 2025, showed that the School was good. It is important to the Governors, Parents and Staff that we all work together to maintain our standards in an ever changing and increasingly challenging education system. To this end we are always evolving and embrace the opportunities that new staff may bring to the school.

There are two classes within each year group – Foundation Stage, Year 1 and Year 2 which are taught by enthusiastic and talented staff.

We encourage parents to support learning through tasks at home, to offer to help in school and on educational visits if they are able and to work together with the school to support the development of their children.
