Subject	Content	How you can support at home
Communication and Language	- I can listen to and then follow an instruction. - I can explain in simple sentences, including ordering, stating what happened and what might happen.	- Encourage children to follow a series of simple instructions, eg 'Put on your shoes and then your coat' - Play listening games such as 'Simon Says'
Personal, Social and Emotional Development	- I can accept the needs of others, and I can take turns and share resources. - I am confident to talk to other children when playing and will communicate freely about my home and community.	Play turn-taking board games and sharing games.
Physical Development	- I can use a pincer grasp. - I can catch a large ball. - I can run skilfully and negotiate space successfully,	- Practice picking up and posting small items such buttons or sequins. - Play throwing and catching games

Mathematics	- I can count objects to 5 and begin to count beyond 10. - I can count out up to 5 objects from a larger group. - I can select the correct numeral to represent 1 to 5, then 1 to 10 objects.	- Count everyday items around the home. - Look for numbers when walking around the community (such as door numbers or on signage) - Match counters or objects to numbers.
Understanding the World	- I can ask questions about aspects of my familiar world such as the place where I live or the natural world. - I understand the effect of changing seasons on the natural world around me.	Go on a nature around the local area – what signs of autumn can you see?
Expressive Arts and Design	- I can draw with increasing complexity and detail, such as representing a face with a circle and including details. - I can sing to myself and make-up simple songs.	- Practice drawing or painting people or favourite story characters. - Sing favourite songs and rhymes. Can you make up some matching dance moves?
