<p>In Computing lessons, children work collaboratively discussing and sharing their ideas. They take turns to talk, listen to others' ideas and make decisions together.</p>	<p>Children consider the benefits of rules when working with technology. This mirrors and reiterates the importance of children following rules and procedures in their daily life.</p>	<p>When working on the laptops there are opportunities for children to make choices about their work. They select and use tools to express their own ideas and choose how they wish to represent and organise data.</p> <p>Children share their ideas and opinions with others when working as a class or in paired and small group work.</p>	<p>Children listen to others' ideas, showing respect.</p> <p>Children are encouraged to value others' work and show respect for the efforts and creativity of their peers.</p>
